# Attenborough Nature Reserve

Take a stroll through Attenborough Nature Reserve on our trentbarton trail. Can you follow the clues, find the letters and spell out a word?



1 Hop off either our **indigo** or **skylink Nottingham** service outside McDonalds and head towards the retail park. On the right hand side of the pavement, there is a sign (don't forget to look up) directing you to the Nature Reserve and a cycling track. **What's the 5th letter on this sign?**



2 Head down the road and over the train line. After you've followed the public footpath down the entrance, head towards the Visitors Centre and there you will find a sign. **What's the 6th letter in the title on the board in front of you?**



3 Head up towards the bridge, on your right there is another board, **what's the 4th letter on there?**



4 Whilst continuing to follow the path you will reach a bird hide. **For the next clue, what is the 2nd letter in the name of the hide?**



5 Ensure you're following the Riverside Path to Beeston and continue along to the next sign relating to the movement of the birds you'll find in the Nature Reserve, **what's the 7th letter in the title?**



6 Turn left at the next crossroads and follow the path. Cross over the big green bridge and head towards the water once two paths meet at Corbetts Meadow. Once you start to see signs for the Visitors Centre again, you're nearly done! **Look to your left and there is another sign, what's the 2nd letter?**



You should be able to see the Visitors Centre in the distance now, that means the walk is done! Why not pop in for a refreshment or hit the shops in the retail park on your way back to the bus stop.
